**ORDER**

1. As per G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> above, Government reserved 10% vacancies of LDC/LD Typist of any Department for the by transfer appointment of eligible employees of Last Grade Servants of the Department. Further G.O read as 2<sup>nd</sup> above was issued to give more clarity to the 1<sup>st</sup> G.O regarding cadre strength date of effect of order etc. As per the G.O read as 3<sup>rd</sup> above, Government ordered to reserve 10% vacancy to be set apart for 'by transfer' appointment from low paid employees from state wide vacancies, if it cannot be set apart district wise and can be appointed regional wise vide G.O cited 5<sup>th</sup> above.

2. Accordingly this office had fixed cadre strength and published seniority list of low paid employees and made appointment in the reserved vacancies kept aside for them. Later as per Government directions viewed in the ref read as 8<sup>th</sup> paper above, this Directorate has been published revised seniority list of low paid employees for 'by transfer' appointment as Clerk vide ref read as 11<sup>th</sup> paper above. As per ref read as 9<sup>th</sup> paper above, it was specified that the reserved vacancies left to be unfilled in Thiruvananthapuram and Kozhikode region will be filled as and when open vacancies arise in Thiruvananthapuram and Kozhikode region.

3. In the extent, one vacancy has arouse in Thiruvananthapuram region and three vacancies have arisen in Kozhikode region due to the retirement and in addition to the retirement of employees appointed under by transfer in Ernakulam and Kollam region. The details are as shown below :-

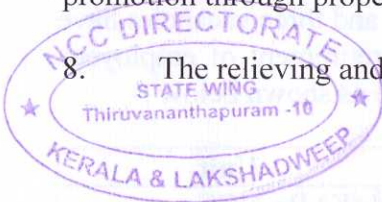

8. The relieving and joining in r/o the above concerned should be intimated to this office.


