NCC Department – Establishment – By transfer appointment from Low paid Employees to the post of Clerk in the scale of pay of Rs.26500-60700 – Appointment of Clerk - Orders issued.

O R D E R

1. The various rules regarding By-transfer appointment from Low Paid Employees to the post of LDC have been enumerated in the G.Os and letters read as 1 to 6 paper above.
2. As per G.O cited 1st Government reserved 10% of vacancies of LDC/LDT of any department for the eligible employees of last grade servants of that department. The 2nd G.O cited above was issued to give more clarity to the 1st G.O regarding cadre strength, date of effect of order etc. As per the 3rd G.O cited, Government ordered to set apart 10% of the vacancies for 'by transfer' promotion from LPE of state wide vacancies, if it cannot be set apart district wise. This Directorate issued 'By Transfer' appointment to the eligible senior most Low paid employees to the post of clerk in the reserved vacancies vide this Directorate order read as 9th paper above, where in Sri. Suresh K (PEN-478733), Lascar Gde-II of 11 (K) Bn NCC, Alappuzha was ordered to be posted as Clerk in the same unit. But, he has submitted his statement of relinquishment of promotion permanently vide ref cited 10th paper above.
3. Therefore, the matter was again examined in detail. The request for relinquishment of Sri.Suresh K is hereby accepted. The next senior most eligible candidate in the seniority list vide this Directorate Proceedings read as 7th paper above is Sri.Santhosh S (PEN-373284), who was promoted as LDT vide this Directorate proceedings No.0694/A2-III/Est/2021/NCC dated 18 Nov 2021 and posted at NCC Gp HQ, Kollam. But he retired on 30 Apr 2022. The next senior Sri.Surendran KT (PEN-498369), Lascar Gde I has also retired from service on 31 Mar 2023.

4. In the circumstances, Sri. Prasad R (PEN -364408), Lascar Grade 1 of 9 (K) Bn NCC, Kottarakkara being the next eligible senior most incumbent is hereby accorded 'By Transfer appointment and appointed as Clerk in the scale of pay of Rs.26500 – 60700/- and is posted to 10 (K) Bn NCC, Chengannur.
5. He will be on probation in the cadre of Clerk for a period of two years on duty within a continuous period of three years from the date of joining of duty as Clerk vide para 4 (1) of GO (P) No.17/2018/P&ARD dated 27 Dec 2018.
6. The Original educational qualification certificates should be verified by the Head of Office of respective Group HQ/Unit to where the individual is being posted. The incumbent, if not willing to join duty as clerk should submit the unwillingness to this Directorate through proper channel within 10 days from the date of receipt of this order.
7. Necessary entries will be made in the Service Book of the incumbent under proper attestation and the date of joining duty should be intimated. The head of Office is requested to relieve the above employee so as to enable him to join the duty in the appointed post of Clerk in the scale of pay of Rs.26500-60700.
